Doll pattern

Double Knitting yarn in various colours and $4 \mathrm{~mm} /$ size 8
needles.

Cast on 32sts

Work in stocking stitch as follows choosing a different colour for each section:

4 rows for the shoes
14 rows for the trousers
12 rows for the jumper
10 rows for the face
10 rows for the hat

Cut a long end and thread through the 32 sts to pull up the top of the hat and fasten off then sew the back seam together.

The hat and jumper also look good in stripes.

A baby in a baby-gro could be knitted as follows:
30 rows in pale blue or pink then the face in beige/cream and the hat in the main colour.

I've made a snowman in all white and you could make Santas with 2 rows of white at the top of the trouser section for the fur trim.

There are many variations possible.

The dolls are then stuffed and the bottom sewn together.
